MTM Junior is the first annual youth media study in Canada and is a division of the Media Technology Monitor. Based on an online panel, the MTM JR. has spoken with over 1,660 households split equally among Anglophones and Francophones. Of the 1,660 households surveyed, data for 2,270 children was collected.
